Owen, Patterson & Owen wins \$3.2M

Law firm Owen, Patterson & Owen of Valencia secured a \$3.2 million settlement March 4 on behalf of a woman attending a 2009 John Legend concert at the historic Greek Theatre in Los Angeles.

Damages were awarded to concertgoer Denise Herron as compensation for a nearly severed leg Herron suffered while exiting the parking lot; a lot dubbed as "The Jungle" by parking-lot attendees.

A 35-year safety consultant, along with The Greek Theatre's facility manager and parking lot attendee testified that the parking lot had endangered safety of concertgoers for the past eight years.

Herron's leg was shattered, which is how it remains to this day despite four major surgeries. Beverly Hills orthopedic surgeon Keith Liberman, M.D., testified that there is substantial probability her leg may never heal.

"What occurred in that parking lot in Sept. 2, 2009, was unconscionable," said Greg Owen, lead trial counsel.
